Face-to-Face Instruction Parent/Student Agreement

Face-to-face instruction is currently being permitted at all campuses in the Carrizo Springs CISD (CSCISD). Our traditional classrooms and campus setting will look very different when students return. As per the CSCISD Back-to-School Safety Plan for Parents and Staff During COVID-19 handbook, safety precautions will be taken to keep students and staff safe. The information below must be reviewed and agreed upon in order for your student to return to face-to-face instruction. Please initial on the lines below once you have reviewed the information and agreed to the protocols put in place.

_____ Wellness Check Before Sending to School and Temperature Check at the Campus

We need parents' cooperation by not sending students to school who are exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms or have had close contact in the last 14 days with a person who has COVID-19. Please contact the school via phone or email if either of these situations apply to your student. As they enter the building, students will have a temperature screening. Any student registering a temperature of 100.0 or higher will be escorted to the designated isolation room at the front office and parents will be called to come pick up their student.

_____ Face Masks and Face Shield Requirements

Schools are expected to comply with the Governor's Executive Order for wearing face coverings over the nose and mouth. Students will be required to wear a facemask and face shield when riding the bus and during the school day while in the classroom and throughout the building. Students will continue to wear face coverings in the classroom and any time they leave their classrooms, such as restroom breaks and class transition times. They will only be allowed to remove their mask and shield while they are eating breakfast and lunch. The school will provide washable facemasks and a face shield. Students will be responsible for disinfecting and returning their face shields every school day. Students will not be allowed into the building unless they are wearing both the facemask and face shield properly.

Failure to comply in wearing a face mask over the nose and mouth along with a face shield will result in the following consequences:

1st Offense – Verbal Warning

2nd Offense — Parent contacted and student sent home for the remainder of the day

3rd Offense – Student assigned to remote learning indefinitely

_____ Visitors and Food

To reduce the risk of furthering the spread of COVID-19, we will be limiting the number of visitors on campus. No outside food or deliveries will be permitted. Students are not permitted to bring and eat food in the classrooms. All food products are to be consumed in the cafeteria.

_____ Water Bottles

Students will be allowed to bring their own disposable water bottles and clearly write their names on the outside of them. Reusable water bottles or containers are not permitted (i.e. YETI, tumblers, thermos or athletic water bottles). All water fountains on campus have been shut off and are unavailable for use.

_____ Chromebook or Laptop

Students will need to bring their school-issued Chromebook or laptop, along with the charging cord, to campus every day fully charged and ready for instructional use. Additionally, students should bring a set of ear buds or headphones to use, and will keep only one side in their ear during instruction. Students may bring their device in a backpack or computer bag.

_____ Virtual (Remote) and Face-to-face Instruction Decisions

As per Texas Education Agency (TEA) guidelines, parents who choose either remote or in person instruction for their student must commit to a full (6 weeks) grading period. Exceptions that will not allow students to return to face-to-face learning might include: non-compliance with safety protocols, disruptive behavior deemed unsafe for other students, etc. The decision for the current six-weeks will remain until the end of the grading period through the respective dates for each grading period:

4th six weeks – February 11, 2021

5th six weeks – April 4, 2021

6th six weeks – May 26, 2021

_____ Attendance

When a face-to-face student accumulates five (5) absences in a grading period, they will be automatically reassigned to remote learning instruction.

Please note that the precautions listed above are necessary to keep all students and staff as safe as possible. If you agree to the terms listed above and will send your student to the Carrizo Springs High School campus for face-to-face instruction on Wednesday, January 6, 2021, initial on the blank lines next to each guideline and complete the information below
