
SHAC INFORMATION

OPEN MEMBER COMMENT/CITIZENS TO BE HEARD: (IF APPLICABLE)

Members of the public will have the opportunity to address the SHAC during this section on any Agenda item or any subject within its jurisdiction. Each speaker should sign in on the Public Comment Sheet available at the SHAC meeting. Speakers should limit their comments to three (3 minutes). If any member deems it necessary, the committee may limit both the number of speakers and the time allotted to each speaker upon motion and a second by any other member. Anyone desiring to speak during the public portion may do so provided such comments are not abusive and/or harassing and the individual places their name upon the sign-in sheet made available prior to the start of each meeting having a public comment portion. Under the law, the SHAC may only take action on items specifically listed on the Agenda. Subject matter presented which is not a part of the Agenda will be referred to the appropriate department for review and subsequent action. Therefore, the SHAC may not take formal action on any requests made during the Public Comment period (Citizens to be Heard) which are not on the agenda, but can refer such requests to school staff for review if appropriate.

DISRUPTION:

The SHAC shall not tolerate disruption of the meeting by members of the audience or individual committee members. Persons attending SHAC meetings shall not delay, interrupt or disrupt the proceedings, or refuse to obey the orders of the presiding officer. Any disruption will result in immediate removal of members of the public and possible action of the committee to remove disruptive individual board members.

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



CSCISD District Nurse

3. Kimberly Zamora welcomed and introduced all in attendance.
4. Kimberly Zamora-SHAC policy and updates: Discussed and reviewed SHAC policy and updates regarding SHAC meetings for all in attendance.
