Symptoms

- MOUTH itching & swelling of the lips, tongue, or mouth
- THROAT itching and/or a sense of tightness in the throat, hoarseness and hacking cough
- SKIN hives, itchy rash, and/or swelling about the face or extremities
- GUT nausea, abdominal cramps, vomiting, and/or diarrhea
- LUNG shortness of breath, repetitive coughing, and/or wheezing
- HEART "thready" pulse, "passing-out"
