2024-25 Student Dress Code

The district's dress code teaches grooming and hygiene, prevents disruption, and minimizes safety hazards. Students and parents may determine a student's personal dress and grooming standards, provided that they comply with the following:

Student IDs (7 th -12 th)	School-issued ID and lanyard	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Required at all times during the school day and for certain school events. Must not deface (erase or cover-up) any part of ID
Tops	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Any collared shirt/blouse Any dress code acceptable t-shirt (see Other Items below), including CSCISD spirit/club t-shirts, and college/university t-shirts 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Shirts must have sleeves (short or long) The midriff must not be exposed when the student goes through the normal activities of a school day (bending, stretching, reaching, etc.) <p>NOT ALLOWED:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Low cut tops with visible cleavage Tank tops, spaghetti straps, midriffs, or bare back tops Tops with sheer, see-through, spandex or other stretch material
Bottoms	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Pants Shorts Capris 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Jeans may be worn by all students grades PreK – 12. Any holes and tears must be covered. Leggings are allowed under jeans to cover holes. (No visible skin) All Bottoms must be worn at the waistline Shorts length must extend to the mid-thigh <p>NOT ALLOWED:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Leggings, tights or stretch pants that are thin, tight fitting, or cling to the body Athletic shorts, sweatpants, wind-pants, drawstring pants, yoga pants and warm-ups Oversized and/or baggy-style pants/shorts/capris Sagging pants Pajama / sleepwear pants
	Skirts, Skorts, Jumpers	Length must be no more than 3" above the knee.
Outerwear Headwear	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Pullover sweatshirts Sweaters Jackets, Coats, Windbreakers School-sponsored jacket Religious headwear 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Appropriately-sized coats and jackets may be worn to school Coats, jackets or pullover sweatshirts with attached hoodies cannot be worn up on the head in the building <p>NOT ALLOWED:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Dusters, oversized coats or trench coats Hats, caps, visors, sunglasses or head coverings inside school buildings
Footwear	Must wear shoes	<p>NOT ALLOWED:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Footwear with steel inserts or devices Shoes with wheels Excessively large footwear Slippers or house-shoes Flip-flops or shower shoes
Hair/ face/ jewelry	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Hair, including facial hair, must be clean, neat, well-groomed No more than two ear piercings per lobe and one small nose stud. 	<p>NOT ALLOWED</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Body piercings, other than 2 ear piercings per lobe and 1 small nose stud Ear gauges, plugs, tunnels Spiked jewelry
Other items	<p>NOT PERMITTED</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Any items or style of clothing, cosmetics, tattoos, jewelry, contact lenses, or hair style worn that displays drugs, depicts scenes of grotesque violence, images of death, sex, alcohol, vaping or tobacco Articles of clothing or accessory depicting any obscene, profane, or vulgar statements or signs/symbols 	

It is the responsibility of parents to see that students attend school within the district's dress code policy. At any time during the school year, the campus principal may prohibit any grooming practice, article of clothing, or accessory including an emblem or logo, that is determined to be a safety concern or distraction.

The final determination of acceptable dress and grooming rests with the campus administrator.
