Intent and Purpose

The purpose of Title I, Part A is to ensure that all children, particularly low-achieving children in the highest-poverty schools, have a fair, equal, and significant opportunity to obtain a high-quality education and reach, at a minimum, proficiency on challenging State academic achievement standards and the State academic assessments.

Title I, Part A provides supplemental resources to Carrizo Springs C.I.S.D. to help schools with high concentrations of students from low income families that will provide a high-quality education which will help enable all children to meet the state student performance standards.

Title I, Part A supports schools in implementing either a school-wide program or a targeted assistance program. Carrizo Springs C.I.S.D. supports schools in implementing a School-wide Program at:
