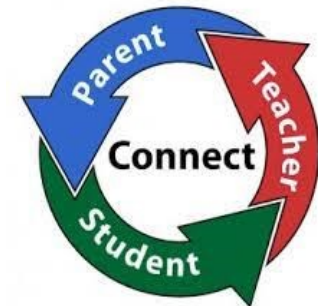

Instruction used at CSJH:

Carrizo Springs Junior High provides their students a high-quality curriculum and instruction that enables children to meet the State's academic achievement standards.

Curriculum used:

Math uses Go Math Book and TEKS

Science uses McGraw Hill, Scientific Minds, Study Island, EdGenuity, and EdPuzzle

History uses EdGenuity, Study Island, and Prentice Hall Textbook

ELAR uses Houghton Mifflin Harcourt

All subjects use the TEKS Resource System TCMPK as a Scope and Sequence, along with Google Classroom as a platform for delivering instruction.

These curriculums are also used to achieve the Parent and Family Engagement School Goals for the 20-21 school year.

Social and Emotional Support for the Learning Environment

The Carrizo Springs Junior High currently offers social emotional support for their students by:

- ◆ Creating a counselor's page on the CSJH website
- ◆ Offering referrals to students who may need counseling services
- ◆ Offering virtual meetings for students
- ◆ Providing an introduction video explaining the role of the counselor
- ◆ Starting Sept 8th offering short counseling (one minute) sessions with students

Math
