- (1) Eligible Applicants must live and work in a Texas rural county with fewer than 68,750 in population;
- (2) Whose story and work through service, education, leadership, innovation or engagement contributes to positive social impact or community improvement and well-being; and
- (3) Whose effort is already having an impact but could go farther and have greater impact with financial support.

One \$15,000 scholarship will be awarded
