
Timeline | Child-Centered Special Education Process



Exceptions

- Parent repeatedly fails or refuses to produce the child for the evaluation [34 CFR § 300.301(d)(1)]; or
- Child who is enrolled in public school and transfers from another local educational agency (LEA) while the evaluation is pending (refer to <u>Children who Transfer</u> framework); or
- Child who is enrolled in public school and is absent three or more days during the evaluation period (extended by number of school days absent)
 [TEC 29.004(a)(1)]; 19 TAC § 89.1011(c)(i)]; or
- Consent is received at least 35 but less than 45 school days before the end of the school year (due by June 30), and the initial ARDC to be held by the 15th school day of the following school year. If the child is absent three or more days during the period, the evaluation is due not later than 45 school days plus the number of days the child is absent [TEC § 29.004(a-1); TEC § 29.004(a)(1); 19 TAC § 89.1011(e); 19 TAC § 89.1011(c)(i)].
